First, we would like to invite all our candidates to our “Get to know you meeting” from 3-4 pm at The Shanty Restaurant, 38985 North Route 41, Wadsworth, on Sunday, August 30<sup>th</sup>, 2020. We will have a light snack and opportunity to have an open discussion with all our queens and ambassadors about our commitment to Wadsworth. We will also address all pageant outfit questions and hand out a simple guide to follow with all expectations for the pageant rehearsal and pageant day.

**\*\*\*Only one adult per contestant is allowed to attend wearing face masks and 6ft of social distancing seating guidelines.**

**Entry Deadline:** In order to become a Community Ambassador and pageant contestant, all applications must be submitted by Saturday September 5<sup>th</sup>, 2020.

**Mandatory Pageant Rehearsal/Interviews:**

Our rehearsal and interviews will be conducted on Sunday morning from 10-11:30 am, September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 at The Shanty’s Outside Tent. Official pageant will start approximately at 1 pm.

**Please bring all of your shoes that you plan to wear for the pageant for practicing your runway walk.**

**Day of the Pageant:**

The Pageant, Rehearsal and Interviews will be held on **Sunday September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 10-11:30 am. Held at: The Shanty's Outdoor Tent, 38985 North Route 41, Wadsworth, IL 60083.**

**Rehearsal and Interviews with the Judges will start at 10 am.**

**Each contestant will have a designated time slot for your interview. Please wait in the lobby until you are prompted to enter the judging station.** Each contestant will have a personal interview by our panel of judges. The interviews will be held at: The Shanty's Outdoor Tent, 38985 North Route 41, Wadsworth, IL 60083.

The first points of the competition will be tabulated. The candidates will leave after their interview/rehearsal to relax and eat lunch and practice on the runway. **The candidates should then arrive back at The Shanty Tent by 12:30 pm** to prepare for the pageant and vote for Miss Congeniality.

**The formal pageant will start approximately at 1:00pm.**

Contestants will appear before the panel of Judges in casual wear (best dress or stylish outfit), and evening gown-formal wear. The scoring of the competition will be as follows:

The points for PERSONAL INTERVIEW - (best dress or Sunday suit); points for SPEECH AND COMMUNICATION SKILLS- and points for STAGE PRESENCE- (evening gown-formal wear) are decided by a panel of distinguished judges. The judges give the results immediately in a sealed envelope to the emcee for results.

*Total from these events will determine the 2020 Wadsworth Area Queens. They will represent us at the Lake County State Pageant Competition in April 2021.*

**Junior speech:**

**"A platform charity event you would implement during your reign"** (45 seconds)

**Miss speech:**

## Wadsworth Area Pageant 2020 Eligibility Rules

Must be a US citizen and meet specific age requirements for the division competing in and never been convicted of a felony offense.

AND

Must be a resident of Wadsworth (principal residence in the village limits). And you may also be eligible if you live within certain geographical limits of the Newport/Millburn Areas. The pageant committee may ask for verification of your residency. Please be prepared to bring your real estate tax bill or other form of proof.

The Miss candidate must be single and never married or had a marriage annulled or had a child.

*If you win the title of Miss Wadsworth Area Queen, you must agree to represent Wadsworth with the utmost dignity and grace at the Lake County State Pageant Competition in April 2021. The Queens are also required to participate in other Lake County Parades, Pageant Events and Lake County Queen event when at all possible.*

*It must be understood that all Queen Appearances and planned events must be approved by the Wadsworth Area Pageant Director, via phone or e-mail.*

Should the Queen marry, become pregnant, move out of Wadsworth, enter another pageant without the Pageant Director's permission, or in any way become ineligible through misconduct etc., she must immediately relinquish her title, crown and prizes to the next eligible runner-up. The Wadsworth Pageant Director will administer this provision with the utmost integrity and sensitivity.

3. Must be 16 years old by September 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020 and not reach her 23<sup>rd</sup> birthday by April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021.
4. Must be single and never married, had a marriage annulled or been pregnant.
5. Must not have been disqualified in any previous Wadsworth Area Pageant or had her title revoked for any reason whatsoever. Must not have had a sibling disqualified in any previous Wadsworth Pageant or had her title revoked for any reason whatsoever.
6. Must agree that time, manner and method of conducting the pageant shall be established by the Pageant Director and Pageant committee rules and guidelines.

\*The scoring system gives 40 points for Personal Interview, 30 points for Speech and Communication Skills (60 second speech about an important charity and how you will implement an event to benefit the charitable organization if you are selected Miss Wadsworth Area 2019). 30 points for Stage Presence (Evening Gown).

## ***2020 Little Miss Wadsworth Area Pageant Rules***

1. Must be a United States Citizen.
2. Must be a female resident of Wadsworth (60083), or other outlined areas listed in the eligibility letter.
3. Must be 6-9 years old by September 13<sup>th</sup> 2020 and not reach her 10th birthday by February 1, 2021.
4. Must not have been disqualified in any previous Wadsworth Area Pageant or had her title revoked for any reason whatsoever. Must not have had a sibling disqualified in any previous Wadsworth Pageant or had her title revoked for any reason whatsoever.
5. Must agree that time, manner and method of conducting the pageant shall be established by the Pageant Director and Pageant committee rules and guidelines.
6. Can only hold one title per year in Lake County, Il.

\*The scoring system gives 40 points for Personal Interview, 30 points for Speech and Communication Skills, be prepared to talk about a 30 second speech on "What a friend means to me." 30 points for Stage Presence (Evening Gown).

7. Must turn in completed application along with a recent picture for photo and press releases.
8. Must agree to appear at all events, parades etc. that the Wadsworth Area Pageant Director and Committee have requested along with other obligations, unless excused by the committee and director. Must submit ideas in writing to director with a project plan and follow through with the plan if it has approved by the committee and abide by their decisions.
9. If chosen Little Miss Wadsworth Area you must agree to represent Wadsworth with the utmost dignity, grace and show leadership at all times with your fellow queens. Agree to community service work and other events throughout the year i.e.: Wadsworth Easter Egg Hunt, Annual Golf Outing Fundraiser event in May and many more functions that may arise.
10. Should the Little Queen act inappropriately or dismiss her duties, move out of Wadsworth, or in any way become ineligible, she must immediately relinquish her title, crown and prizes to the next eligible runner-up. This provision will be administered with the utmost integrity and sensitivity by the Pageant Committee.
11. **The judges' decisions are final. All judges are non-biased, not paid and are selected based on their qualifications and have no association with the Village of Wadsworth. Judges scores are done individually, and they do not know how the other judges are scoring and do not know who the winner is until all tabulations are done and the winner is announced. Scoring sheets are kept confidential and destroyed immediately after the pageant.**
12. **We expect that you and your family and friends will show good sportsmanship before, during and after the pageant. Do not confront the judges, tabulators or pageant committee after the pageant with questions on scoring. If this policy is not adhered to, we reserve the right to refuse you and your sibling's applications in future pageants.**

13. The Wadsworth Area Pageant, and the responsibilities to it, does not end with the crowning of Little Miss Wadsworth, rather, the responsibilities and the Pageant rules commence with the submission of the application and continue in effect throughout the entire term of the winner's title. Any display of bad sportsmanship or confrontations of other entrants or village personnel during the entire term will subject the title holder to revocation of her title and the disqualification of her and her siblings from any future pageant competitions or titles. Any acts of the family and friends of the pageant participant can and will be considered to be acts of the participant. Furthermore, if you cannot fulfill the expressed duties, violate any rule set forth, or conduct yourself in a manner unbecoming of a queen and representative of the Village of Wadsworth, you will immediately relinquish your title, crown, sash, and all prizes upon the direction of the Wadsworth Pageant Director.
